



Strategic Scrutiny Meeting – Terms of Reference

- A quarterly meeting to scrutinise the organisational and operational performance of the Lancashire Constabulary, against the priorities outlined in the PCC's Police and Crime Plan and the Chief Constable's Vision, Mission and Strategic Priorities.
- To oversee the scrutiny arrangements by which the PCC holds the Chief Constable to account, including the production of a Scrutiny Plan.
- To oversee the production of the PCC's Annual Report.
- To review performance exception reports as requested by the PCC, focussing on those issues considered to be of particular interest and concern to the communities of Lancashire.
- To receive scrutiny reports from members of the OPCC, relating to their areas of responsibility.
- To receive updates on inspection findings by HMIC and other inspectorate bodies, ensuring that areas for improvement are identified and addressed.
