**NOTE ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE NEW CORPORATE PLANNING AND
SCRUTINY FRAMEWORK**

Over the summer we have been developing a new corporate planning and scrutiny framework. This has now been finalised with agreement of the Commissioner and the Chief Constable at the first meeting of the new joint Strategic Planning Board on 21 August.

The framework involves a quarterly joint Strategic Planning Board at which the Commissioner will provide strategic direction for the Constabulary and oversee plans to ensure that activity is focused upon achieving the aims and objectives identified within the Police and Crime Plan, and reflecting the Chief Constable's Vision, Mission and Strategic Priorities; and quarterly meetings to scrutinise the organisational and operational performance of the Constabulary, against the priorities outlined in the Commissioner's Police and Crime Plan and the Chief Constable's Vision, Mission and Strategic Priorities. Seminars will be scheduled quarterly and additional seminars will be held as required.

In effect, there will now be a joint strategic meeting scheduled every month: a Planning Board, a Scrutiny Meeting or a Seminar. Additional seminars may be arranged on an ad hoc basis as required.
