SUBJECT: HMIC Summary of Inspections Programme 2017/2018

1 Issue for Consideration

The purpose of this report is to provide an update to the Commissioner in respect of the HMIC Inspection programme for 2017/2018.

3 Background

- Unannounced Crime Data Integrity – HMIC have made contact with HMIC Force Liaison Officer Christine Wilkinson and Force Crime Registrar Erica Fisk to inform us that the Inspection will be w/c 19th June until 30th June.

HMIC have requested a randomised and date ordered sample selection (2355 calls in total) for the Lancashire Crime Date Integrity Inspection. The FCR's team are in the process of downloading all the above calls.

- HMIC Spring 2017 Efficiency, Legitimacy and Leadership Inspection is w/c 3rd July 2017 and the data and document returns have been sent back to the HMIC.
