SUMMARY:	<p>Funding to extend the BID Warden hours into the evenings for the past 12 months has proved effective and has led to a significant increase in engagement and communication between city centre businesses. Experience throughout this year has shown that ASB levels are still an issue in early evenings but tend to ease off from teatime as licensed premises security staff come on duty.</p> <p>Funding will be given used for a 12-month period to pay for the BID Warden contract to be further extended from the current 5 to a 7 day per week service. This would ensure a constant visible deterrent to ASB in the city centre. It would also mean two Wardens would work on a rota ensuring cover is available during any periods of absence from someone who is already a familiar face and knows the most prolific offenders.</p>
