CrossFit is an intense, functional fitness training methodology that focuses on building core strength, endurance, and resilience. It encompasses a holistic approach, incorporating elements of gymnastics, weightlifting, cardio, and teamwork, making it an ideal platform for character development. Their young people are referred through the local neighbourhood policing teams. Once referred and engaged, they will attend the 180 CrossFit facility in Blackburn x3 per week. At each session they will learn a new skill and complete a tough workout alongside peer mentors who have been in their position – who will motivate and influence. They will finish with a 'huddle'. This will be an informal group discussion exploring key topics/challenges they are facing. From this they will refer into specialist 1-1 and group therapy as necessary. The group will also learn to cook and share a healthy meal together and will also progress the young

Licensing SAVI is a Police Crime Prevention Initiatives (PCPI) product, a police-owned organisation whose mission is to achieve sustainable reductions in crime through design and other approaches to help people live in a safer society.
